



Visitation Guidelines

Thrive Upstate encourages everyone to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. The visitation guidelines below are subject to change at any time in response to positive cases, guidance from health officials, or other factors.

- Offsite, including overnight visitation, is allowed for all residences. Outdoor visits at the residences are also continuing and encouraged.
- Visitation inside Thrive Upstate residences is allowed. Visits should be scheduled in advance. Visitors must follow standard protocols of using a mask, hand sanitizing, avoiding high traffic areas, etc.
- Visits should not occur if there have been any recent cases of Covid-19 in the household or among others participating in the visit.
- Visits to the Day Programs are also allowed. These visits should be scheduled in advance. Visitors should arrive at the main entrances to the program, be screened for Covid, and follow safety protocols.

The public health emergency is not over. There is still great risk to individuals with disabilities of contracting and dying from Covid-19. We encourage you to be cautious, prudent, and safe with your visitations. You are also encouraged to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.
